Are you 18 years of age or older and adopted between the ages of 0-2?



Those who were adopted in early childhood may experience ongoing struggles into adulthood, even if they were adopted into caring families. Research has shown that identity can be strongly influenced by the knowledge that one was adopted, influencing one's view of him- or herself and his or her relationship with others.

Our study is investigating how the experience of being adopted in early childhood affects individuals in adulthood.
